ARCHITECTURAL BOOTH DRAWING GUIDELINES

Required for 400 sq. ft. or larger
And End Cap Display Guidelines*

The AAP Show Management requires that all exhibitors with a booth of 400 sq.ft. or larger must submit a scale Booth Drawing for review and show management approval. Drawings must be complete with elevations, dimensions, booth construction, lighting elements, components, hanging sign including truss, hoist & motors if applicable. Drawing can be submitted as a PDF.

Drawing must be submitted to Claude Adomaitis, Exhibits Plus Global Trade Show Management via e-mail: claude@exhibitsplusglobal.com no later than **August 21, 2025**. You will receive approval of your plan or written notice of changes by September 1, 2025.

If there are corrections, a final version must be submitted and approved by the Academy by September 5. (*Note that the Academy reserves the right to review all booth design graphics in order to ensure that they meet the criteria for exhibiting and may require companies to submit graphics prior to final approval.*)

Include following information with your booth drawing:

- Exhibiting Company Name (as listed on AAP Application and Contract for Exhibit Space)
- Booth Number, Size and Configuration (example: 20' X 20', Island)
- Highest Point of Structure
- Highest Point of Hanging Sign or related part, if applicable
- Height, Length, Size of Structure, Components, Profiles, Uprights, Beams, Truss
- Materials (example: Fabric, Metal System Structure, Box Frame Panels, Hardboard)

Flame Retardant Certificate must be available to Fire Watch personnel. All fabric, draperies, curtains and other similar furnishings and decorations should be flame resistant and/or flame-retardant treated to the satisfaction of the authority having jurisdiction.

The AAP Exhibitor Regulations must allow 50% see-through visibility from all four sides. No part of the booth structure or hanging sign may exceed the maximum height of 20' from the floor [including lighting, truss, arm light fixtures, chain hoist motor or related parts]

***End Cap Display Guideline:** Maximum back wall height allowed is 8ft high only in the center 10ft of your booth, with a 4ft height restriction on all materials in the remaining space.
